The Withings Health Mate Application is the manifestation of the Withings Health Cloud. It's the key for mastering all around well-being. Launched in August 2012, this free application is available on all iOS and Android devices. It simplifies the ways in which any user can monitor, improve and share their weight, physical activity, blood pressure and quality of sleep. The app aggregates information entered manually, sent from the Withings scales, Blood Pressure Monitor, and Smart Activity Tracker, and other partnering devices.

Connected Body Scales: In 2009, Withings launched the first ever **Wi-Fi Body Scale** connected to the Internet (129€), followed by the next generation version, the **WS-30**, in November 2012 (119€).



Withings continues its evolution in connected scales with the **Smart Body Analyzer** being released at CES 2013. This will be the first-ever communicating body scale to feature heart rate measurement and bedroom air quality monitoring alongside traditional weight and body fat measurements. Withings allows users to easily follow the history of their weight on an iPhone, Android phone or computer.

Blood Pressure Monitor: In May 2011, Withings marked a pinnacle moment in connected health with the first Smart Blood Pressure Monitor that connected directly into the iPhone ($129 \in$) dock connector. Early detection of trends is the best way to stay healthy and the blood pressure monitor helps do just that.







Smart Baby Monitor: Withings reinvented the traditional baby monitor in 2011 by launching the Smart Baby Monitor that communicates directly with the iPhone, iPad and iPod Touch. It is a simple way to stay closer to your little one, even when you're on the other side of the world (299 €).

Smart Kid Scale: This scale enables parents to control, understand and share the growth of their baby in a simple way. The Smart Kid Scale has been recognised with an award from the Observeur du Design 2013 and CES Innovations Honoree Award in 2012.







Smart Activity Tracker: Unveiled at CES Las Vegas 2013, Smart Activity Tracker is a connected sensor which enables you to measure your physical activity, quality of your sleep and heart rate in a brand new way. The device connects with the Withings Health Mate app via Bluetooth and Bluetooth Smart connection.

In September 2009, Withings launched the World's first **Wi-Fi Body Scale** that was connected to the Internet. Since then, Withings has been a pioneer in Health 2.0. Withings' initial capital was 2 million Euros. In 2012, Withings raised an additional 3 million Euros from Ventech.

Withings' key markets include the USA (45% turnover), Europe (40%, of which 10% in France and 15% in Germany) and Asia-Oceana (15%). Rather than concentrating on distributing its products in pharmacies and specialized shops, Withings distributes its products within the most prestigious consumer electronic shops and major retailers such as FNAC, Apple Stores and Best Buy.
